



Flea Treatment Preparation Instructions

Time:

- Remove all items from carpeted areas throughout home. This includes closets.
- Remove all items from beneath furniture, do not place on upholstered furniture as this will need to be treated.
- Remove and launder any dog beds and/or bedding and launder or discard in plastic bag prior to treatment(s).
- Thoroughly vacuum throughout home using a vacuum with a beater brush which causes vibrations. This should be done daily between treatments and for 2 weeks after final treatment to help prompt fleas to emerge from pupal casings. Thoroughly mop any non-carpeted areas.
- Cover any fish tanks with a towel and unplug air pump for the duration of the vacate time.
- Remove, seal and/or cover any food items left in the home.
- Tenants and pets must vacate for 4 hours from the time of pest technician arrival. Notify pest control in advance if you are unable to remove any pets so that arrangements can be altered.
- Please notify your landlord, property manager or pest control if there are any pregnancies or medical concerns with the treatment. We can send pesticide label(s) and Safety Data Sheet(s) to discuss with your doctor prior to treatment.
- Bring any flea harboring pets to a veterinarian prior to initial treatment or otherwise as soon as possible for flea treatment.
- Notify pest control if you have no pets as inspection may be necessary to identify other flea harboring wildlife introducing fleas to your home.
- Do not enter home until after the re-entry time has expired. You may open windows to ventilate home if you would like but is not necessary.
